Admission Early Action Deadline: November 15, 2024



STEP 1. Create your Online Admissions Portal

- The first step for all prospective students is to create an online admissions account so our team can personalize your ND experience. Creating a profile is simple, does not require a payment or commitment, and is your first step to learning more about our amazing community.

STEP 2. Begin your Admission Application

- When you are ready to start your admission application, access the application through your online admissions portal.



STEP 3. Submit your Recommendations to ND

- We require two recommendations - one recommendation should be from your Guidance Counselor or Principal and the other recommendation should be from your 8th grade Math or English Teacher.
- Request your recommendations in your admissions portal.



STEP 4. Send your 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Report Cards to ND

- Please send 6th and 7th grade report cards immediately and the 8th grade report card as soon as it is available. We will review applications with the first quarter grades from 8th grade.
- Records can be requested through your online admissions portal or by submitting a records release form to your middle school records office to release the 6th, 7th and 8th grade report cards and standardized test scores to ND.



STEP 5. Send your standardized testing from the past two years to ND

- Please request any Connecticut Mastery Tests, Smarter Balanced Assessment results (SBAC testing) or IOWA Basics Tests, or any other standardized testing from the past two years to be sent to ND.
- Our admissions process is holistic, and includes the careful review of every part of your application. Rather than requiring that you take an additional entrance exam, we believe that considering your existing standardized test results along with the other components of your application will provide a full picture of your academic abilities and potential. Please remember that your standardized test scores are only one part of your total application.



Financial Aid: The Financial Aid Committee of Notre Dame High School reviews and distributes financial aid for freshmen applicants based on financial need. In order to be considered for financial aid, you must file and complete a FACTS application by November 15, 2024. - 8th Grade Quarter I Report Card



STEP 5. Send your Standardized Test Scores to ND

- Connecticut Mastery Tests, Smarter Balanced Assessment results (SBAC) or IOWA Assessments
- Any other relevant standardized tests



Early Action Application Deadline is November 15: Early Action provides you with a guaranteed decision date, as well as consideration for a merit scholarship. For many students, this enables better planning.



Rolling Admission Applications: We will begin evaluating applications in early December and start notifying students about decisions approximately every two weeks.
