

GETTING TO NOTRE DAME - WE'RE CLOSER THAN YOU THINK!

One of the great things about attending Notre Dame is the opportunity to meet students from all over Connecticut. Our students come from over fifty different towns, and they come to campus by car, bus, and train.

GETTING TO ND VIA CAR:

Many students are driven to campus each day. Our building is open at 7:00 a.m. to accommodate early arrivals and remains open until 5:00 p.m. to accommodate late pick-ups and student participation in activities.

Juniors and seniors are allowed to park a car on campus. There are a limited number of passes available each year, and passes are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

CARPOOL NETWORK:

To assist families in coordinating transportation to Notre Dame, the Admissions Team will facilitate the creation of a contact list for families. Please note that this is only meant to be a resource for families. The Admission Office is only responsible for collecting and sharing the information, and will not be responsible for actually coordinating any carpools.

If you are interested in appearing on the carpool list for the 2024-2025 school year, please complete the form in the Transportation section on the Class of 2028 website by August 1, 2024.

GETTING TO ND VIA TRAIN:

Many of our students take the train from surrounding communities. They use the CT Hartford and Shoreline East Lines, as well as Metro North. Mail & Ride for Schools offers discounted travel for students traveling daily to school by train. Notre Dame registers students in order for them to qualify for the discounted rate. Please complete the registration form on the Class of 2028 website by August 1, 2024 if you would like to take advantage of the discounted rates.

A shuttle is available to transport students between the West Haven Train Station and campus. The shuttle operates throughout the day to accommodate school hours and after-school activities.

GETTING TO ND VIA BUS:

Bus transportation is available to students coming to Notre Dame from many different towns. Exact routes are determined each year, depending on the number of students from different areas. We currently have three bus routes:

Greater Valley Line - Includes Ansonia, Derby, Milford, Oxford, Seymour, Shelton, Woodbridge **Northern New Haven County Line** - Includes Wallingford, North Haven, Hamden, Northford, Cheshire

West Haven - Includes all points in the city of West Haven

In order for us to coordinate our bus transportation, please register using the form on the Class of 2028 website by August 1, 2024. This will give us adequate time to make the necessary arrangements with our bus provider.

ESTIMATED COSTS (Please note that these are subject to change.):

Train - Fares will vary based on the point of departure.

Bus - The estimated cost for round-trip bus transportation is \$1400. Estimated cost for one-way bus transportation is \$800.
